Pray that you will be merciful whenever the opportunity arises this week.

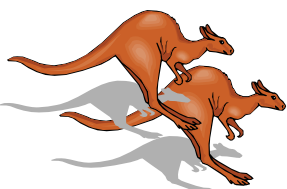
Pray that others will forgive your offences this week.
