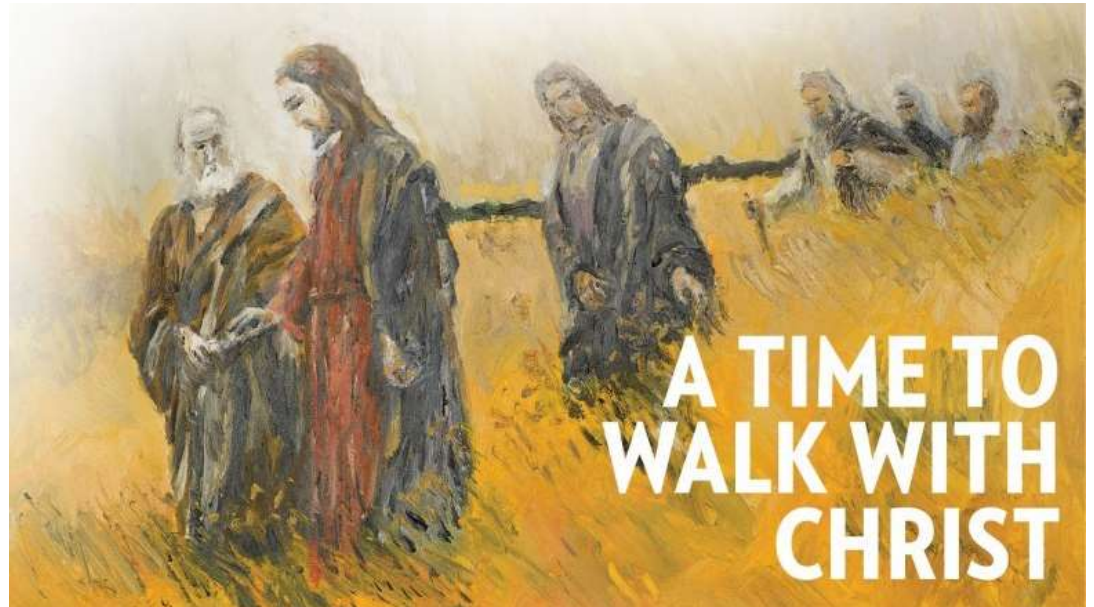

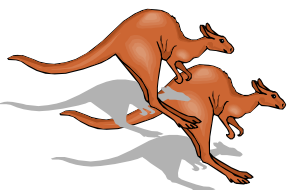

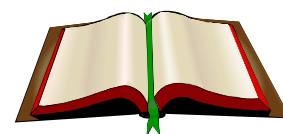

Food items they accept for their care packs include tinned (with pull ring to open) baked beans, spaghetti and tuna, Up and Go or Sustagen, Water, Fruit Tubs, Cup of Soup, Shapes Share Packs, Chip Share Packs, Le Snacks, Sultanas, Jelly beans/Jelly babies, Barley Sugars, Mints.
